

Residential Through floor installation



Mr and Mrs B love their home in Berkshire. However, the kitchen – at the back of the house – is North-facing so never felt light enough.

As someone who is interested in home improvements, Mr B had seen that tubular daylighting systems were a great way to pipe daylight into areas where windows or skylights aren't practical. He confirmed: "One of the main suppliers was extremely offhand, whereas Solatube couldn't have been more helpful

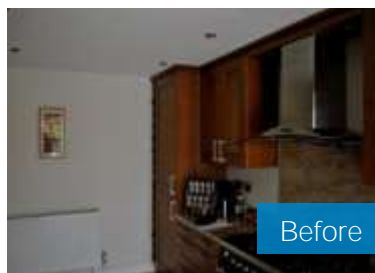
